How to stay Safe During a Heatwave



The weather in the UAE is very hot in the summer, with temperatures reaching 45°C (113°F) and humidity levels exceeding 90% on average. Due to the high temperatures, hot summers can be concerning.

Wear cotton clothes, and make your child wear it under the school uniform



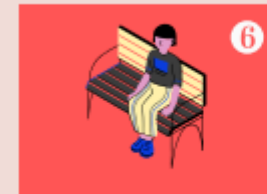
